### **Detailed Description of the Collection**

**2006.8.1 – History of the Construction Division** (n.d.)

A history of the Construction Division during World War I, written by the chief of the Construction Division.

**2006.8.2 – The National Defense Act – The Pay Readjustment Act – Army Pay Tables** (1945)

Amendments as of 1945 to the National Defense Act (1916) and Pay Readjustment Act (1942), with Army Pay Tables.

**2006.8.3 – Quartermaster Support of the Army: A History of the Corps, 1775-1939** (1962)

A comprehensive history of the Quartermaster Corps, one of the oldest and most important supply agencies of the United States Army.

**2006.8.4 – Reorganization of the Army, 1962**

A draft of a study on the reorganization of the Army in 1962.

**2006.8.5 – Organization for national Security** (1963)

This volume represents the main lines of organizational development in the national security area.

**2006.8.6 – Maintenance of Material – U.S. Army, 1958-1963** (1965)

A condensed but cohesive story of U.S. Army maintenance, 1958-1963.

**2006.8.7 – The Sinews of War: Army Logistics, 1775-1953** (1966)

A study of U.S. Army logistics from the Revolutionary War through the Korean War.

**2006.8.8 – The Employment of Local Nationals by the U.S. Army in Europe (1945-1966)** (1968)

A fully documented account of the policies and procedures applied to the employment of local nationals since the end of World War II.

**2006.8.9 – The Kaiser Story** (1968)

The story of Henry J. Kaiser and of the people with whom he built Kaiser Industries.

**2006.8.10 – An Analysis of Maintenance Support Plans for Selected U.S. Army Combat Vehicles – A Thesis** (1969)

A logistics management thesis.

**2006.8.11 – A History of the United States Army Materiel Command, 1962-1968**  
(1969)

A history of AMC, from its inception through 1968.

**2006.8.12 – Two Centuries of Service: The Army's Civil Contributions to American Society: Draft Manuscript** (December 1975)

A collection of articles addressing topics such as explorers, governors and diplomats, domestic peace-keeping, the Army medical department, public works, technological contributions, education and art, community relations, and disaster relief and rescue operations.

**2006.8.13 – Combined Operations in Peace in War** (1982)

A brief historical analysis of the experience of allied forces in achieving practical military cooperation in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

**2006.8.14 – The Role of FORSCOM in the Reception and Care of Refugees from Cuba in the Continental United States** (1984)

Presentation of the background to previous attempts by the U.S. Government and the U.S. Army in particular to receive and care for large numbers of refugees involved in a mass exodus from a Communist-dominated country.

**2006.8.15 – Legacy in the Sand: The United States Army Armament, Munitions and Chemical Command in Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm** (1992)

A chronicle of AMCCOM's efforts in Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

**2006.8.16 – Theater Logistics and the Gulf War** (1994)

A comprehensive study of all aspects of theater logistics support in the Gulf War.

**2006.8.17 – Contributions to Science and Technology: A History** (1995)

Recounts the technical achievements of the Army laboratories at Watertown, Massachusetts.

**2006.8.18 – United States Army Logistics, 1775-1992 – An Anthology** (1992)

An introduction to the soldier and student of logistics a variety of topical selections that cover 200 years of our Army's history.

**2006.8.19 – The United States Army in Operation Iraqi Freedom: Final Draft** (2003)

The story of America's Army in OIF.

**2006.8.20 – Eyes of Artillery: The Origins of Modern U.S. Army Aviation in World War II** (2000)

In-depth study of the origins of modern Army Aviation in the United States.
