Mr. John Campbell currently serves as the Deputy Chief of Staff for the Joint Munitions Command. In this position, he supervises the Command General Staff and the Environmental, Health and Safety Directorate.

Campbell ensures daily execution of the command mission and strategic efforts are maintained for senior leadership. Campbell provides specific focus and guidance in areas of finance, personnel, audit, information technology, security and safety/environmental domains across the command.

Campbell's past assignments include acting Executive Director for Ammunition and the Deputy to the Commander for JMC; Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management Director, Sustainment Operations; Chief, Small Caliber Division; Chief, Requirements Planning Division; Chief, Production Quality Management Division; Lead Quality Assurance Specialist focused on JMC Installation quality support programs; and assignments as a Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belt and Black Belt for the command.

Campbell was the 16th certified Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belt in the U.S. Army, leading and coaching projects across JMC's headquarters. He holds a Master of Science in business administration from Texas A&M University, Texarkana, Texas, and a Bachelor of Science in computer science from the University of Iowa, Iowa City.

Campbell is Level III certified for Financial Management. He is also Level III Army Acquisition Corps certified in Business Financial Management as well as Production, Quality and Manufacturing.
