Chemical Munitions Storage & Surveillance

HISTORY:

The Blue Grass Chemical Activity (BGCA) supported delivery of chemical munitions to Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (BGCAPP) for destruction and was responsible for the safe and secure storage of the chemical weapons stockpile at Blue Grass Army Depot (BGAD). BGCA reports to the U.S. Army Chemical Materials Activity. BGCAPP completed agent destruction operations on July 7, 2023, marking the complete destruction of all chemical weapon stockpiles declared to the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons.

FACILITIES:

BGCA is housed on 250 acres of the 15,000-acre Blue Grass Army Depot, in Richmond, Kentucky.
