


Commander's Environmental Stewardship Challenge

With specific challenge to:


- Reducing waste treated at open burn ground by 50%
 - Ended 2019 with a 37% waste reduction
 - 2020 trending is favorable
 - BAE Systems has challenged tenants to help reduce OBG waste
 - Continuous Improvement (CI)
 Team has been recruited to help continue OBG waste reduction





Commander's Environmental Stewardship Challenge

- ❖ A3 Problem Solving
 - Structured problem solving that helps drive continuous improvement
 - First employed by Toyota and used in lean manufacturing
 - Provides a simple and strict procedure that guides problem solving
 - Allows everyone impacted by the issue to see the problem in the same light

❖ A3 Problem Solving


- CI team includes a cross functional blend of operators, supervisors, waste handlers, continuous improvement specialists, environmental specialists, and Army personnel
- Work toward overcoming the specific challenges to achieve goal
- Continue to reduce OBG waste until the contained burn chamber is built and commissioned
