11 June 2018 Fire

- Flash Fire occurred on plant Monday, 11 June 18
- Three of our teammates received burn injuries
 - One has been released
 - One remains hospitalized
 - Andrew passed away on Saturday, 16 June 18
- Plant began staggered restart Thursday night
- Army, OSHA, and BAE investigations ongoing

Commander's Environmental Stewardship Challenge

I challenge Team Radford to help us take care of our home, the New River Valley. To continue to preserve the environment and strengthen and maintain transparency with the communities in which we live and work. To continue to *think*, *innovate*, and *action* beyond compliance.

With specific challenge to:

- Immediately reduce lead from the open burn ground
- Reducing waste treated at open burn ground by 50%; New EWI treat 95% of current waste
- □ Reduce waste, water, and power consumption as low as reasonably achievable
- ☐ Reduce the amount of nitrates released into the New River



EWI: Energetic Waste Incinerator





Lead and Total Waste Reduction



Immediately reduced lead going to the open burning ground by 65%



Reduced total pounds of waste treated by 35% this year

- From April 2, 2018, to present, the facility has diverted approximately 282 pounds of lead from the Open Burning Ground to the Explosive Waste Incinerator.
- MK90 Grains have not been treated via Open Burning since May 1, 2018.


Monitoring and Energetic Waste Incinerator



Ambient Monitoring

- Ambient air monitoring is in progress
- PM 2.5, lead, arsenic, chromium
- Collaborating with Virginia Tech





Energetic Waste Incinerator

- The waste environmental permit application will be submitted by the end of the month
- The air environmental permit application will be submitted at the end of July







Compliance Actions

DEQ Notice of Violation

- Issued: 21 December 2017
 For demolition debris that contained lead that was sent to a landfill that was not authorized to accept this type of waste
- Resolution: US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) subcontractor resampled remaining debris and improved protocol for sampling debris ensuring proper disposal procedures
- Long-term resolution: USACE
 will have inspectors on site
 overseeing future demolition efforts
 for proper waste handling and
 disposal procedures

DEQ Warning Letter

- Issued: 3 April 2018
 For wastes with higher lead concentrations that were allowed to be treated at the Open Burning Ground
- Long-term resolution: Waste sample analysis reports are reviewed in greater detail and measures such as analyzing duplicate samples are taken to ensure that the data is good
