

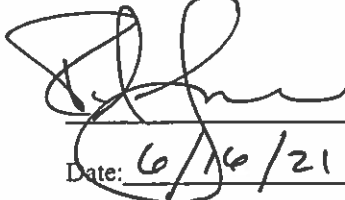

PHILOSOPHY:

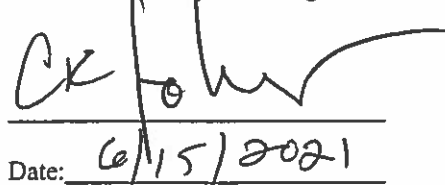

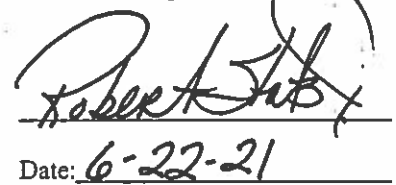
